

Wabasha County
Permit to Carry a Pistol in the State of Minnesota
Renewal Year is here!

You may apply for a renewal permit no earlier than 90 days prior to the expiration date. The renewal fee is \$75.00. If you do not want your permit to expire, you should submit your application package a minimum of 31 days prior to the expiration date. The Sheriff's Office has 30 days to process your application per state statute.

You must have attended an authorized firearms training class within 1 year of your renewal application. (MN Statute 624.714, Subd. 2a) Authorized classes can be given by the approved organizations listed at:

- When completing the form, please check the *renewal* box.

Deliver the application packet in person to the Sheriff's Office in the county where you currently reside. The packet must contain the following:

- *Completed* application, signed and dated by the Applicant
- Applicable fee (see chart below)
- *Original* certificate of completed authorized firearms training
- You must present a current drivers license, state identification card or the photo page of your passport

FEE SCHEDULE:

New Application	\$100.00	Required of all new applications <u>and</u> renewal applications, which have not been renewed within 30 days of the expiration date of the permit.
Renewal Application	\$75.00	No earlier than 90 days prior to the expiration date
Personal Data Change (Address/Name Change)	\$10.00	Must be submitted to the issuing Sheriff within 30 days. <i>Applicant must fill out the required personal data information and sign a new application form.</i>
Reissue (Loss/Destruction)	\$10.00	Must be submitted to the issuing Sheriff within 30 days. <i>Applicant must fill out the required personal data information and sign a new application form.</i>

Permit to Purchase a Firearm

You may apply for a Permit to Purchase by completing the Minnesota Uniform [Firearm Application \(Permit to Purchase or Transfer\)](#).
